

**THE CORPORATION OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF CHAMBERLAIN
BY-LAW NO. 708**

Being a By-Law to set a policy for the installation or replacing of culverts onto private property in the Township of Chamberlain.

WHEREAS Subsection 17 of Section 207 of the Municipal Act R.S.O., 1990, Chapter M.45, as amended, provides that the Council of every Municipality may pass by-laws for permitting and regulating the size and mode of construction of culverts that cross any drains or water course situated on a highway under its jurisdiction;

AND WHEREAS the council of the Township of Chamberlain considers it desirable to set a policy for the installation or replacement of culverts onto private property in the Township of Chamberlain;

AND WHEREAS the Township does not feel that it can properly maintain the ditching and proper drainage of its roads if culverts are installed improperly or are not properly maintained;


NOW THEREFORE The Township of Chamberlain enacts as follows:


1. The size and type of any culvert being installed in Chamberlain Township is to be determined by the road superintendent.
2. Culverts and cover material is to be supplied by the landowner.
3. The Township will supply equipment to install. (loader/backhoe)
4. Prior to the commencement of ditching the property owner shall be notified of the impending work and associated requirements as determined by section 1 of this by-law for replacement of unapproved, non maintained or nonexistent culverts.
5. Any existing culverts found to be defective in the opinion of the road superintendent and are deemed to be impeding road drainage will be the landowners responsibility to replace.
6. There shall only be one entrance per field unless otherwise approved by road superintendent.
7. Failure to comply with the above conditions will result in the problem being rectified by the Township work force with the landowner responsible for all costs.
8. That all by-laws and resolutions, or parts thereof, contrary hereto or inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.

THAT THIS BY-LAW COME INTO CAUSE AND EFFECTIVE AT TIME OF PASSING.
